
Dear parents and carers,

We will put some exercise books outside of school all day tomorrow for you to come and collect one for your child's home learning.















Learning will be delivered in a variety of ways including:

- Pre-recorded lessons from the teacher
- Learning videos
- Power Points
- Directed tasks
- Use of stories and pictures.

Submission of work

All pupils have been provided with an email address and they will use this to email work/photographs of work to their class email address - <u>the class email address is located on their home learning page.</u>

All children are required to send a photo of their learning on the following days:

Will my child receive feedback on their learning?

All pupils will receive feedback on the learning they have submitted to their class email. The feedback will be emailed back to them using their school email address.

What if my child will not complete their learning?

We are very hopeful that all pupils will complete their home learning; however, we know that sometimes they can be reluctant to do this. Teachers will monitor the work that they are submitting and complete the following steps if they do not receive it:

• Phone call home to discuss reasons for work not being submitted (e.g. child could be unwell, technological issues, refusal)

- Discuss a resolution actions to be taken (the child will be involved in the discussion).
- If issues persist, the Head teacher/ Deputy will make contact.

Will my child be able to speak to their teacher?

All teachers are contactable via email and by phone call during school hours. In addition, they will have a weekly Zoom meeting with their teacher, TA and classmates. Miss Wilkinson will also be recording a weekly assembly.
